REQUIREMENTS

- PRIOR** to any burning, contact the Mormon Lake Fire District (354-2231) to make sure that it is still okay to burn. (This should be done daily to ensure that no County Restrictions/Red Flag Warnings are in place).
- The area to be burned **MUST** be inspected by the Mormon Lake Fire District **PRIOR** to any burning (Only necessary on the first burn, if burning on more than one date).
- An adequate water source and delivery system must be present and in working order during the burning.
- The landowner or his designated representative (responsible adult) must be present at all times until the fire is extinguished. A letter of Authorization from the landowner must be presented to the District, before a burning permit is issued (if other than the landowner is doing the burning).
- This permit is for the burning of approved materials in ONE of the following manners:
 Piled or placed in an approved waste burner Ignited in place (field burning) Collected in a pit
- Materials to be burned shall be dry & readily combustible. You may burn the following materials (check all that apply) Weeds/Grass Brush Other untreated organic materials: _____
- You MAY NOT burn** the following materials: Garbage, trash, petroleum products, asphalt shingles, tar paper, treated or glued wood products, plastic and rubber products, tires, electrical wire insulation, clippings sprayed with pesticides, hazardous materials, hazardous material containers, or any product which would produce noxious or toxic fumes.
- Start ignition no earlier than one hour after sunrise and extinguish fire two hours before sunset.
- No burning will be done when sustained winds exceed 10 M.P.H.
- Minimum clearance of 25 feet from any structure or combustibles unless an approved fire break is provided.
- This permit **MUST** be present at the burn site and presented to a Fire, Sheriff or DEQ Officer on demand.
- Coconino National Forest Dispatch (526-0600) **MUST be notified** in advance of burning. (They **do not** give the Permittee permission to burn! Permission is only obtained from the District or ADEQ).
- What types of actions will be taken to minimize fire emissions including any Emission Reduction Techniques (ERTs)?
 Prevent fire spread by lining the area with fire retardant foam or water. Allow the material to dry before burning.
 Extinguish smoldering burns. Other: _____
- * Other Permit Stipulations: Only LPG or liquid fuel canisters that can be shut off.

This permit is issued in cooperation & compliance with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (see also AAC Title 18, Chapter 2, Article 6 & ARS 13.1706). The applicant acknowledges and accepts responsibility for any and all damages which may occur as a result of failure to control or properly extinguish any fires or burning permitted under this permit. The Mormon Lake Fire District or Arizona Department of Environmental Quality may revoke or suspend this permit for environmental conditions, failure to allow inspection, failure to make proper notification, or any conditions that would create a hazard to life or property. Suppression costs will be billed to the land owner for extinguishing any fire that does not comply with the rules, escapes containment, or catches other land/property on fire.


A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MORMON LAKE FIRE DISTRICT OF MORMON LAKE, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO AN OPEN BURN PERMIT FOR ALL PRIVATE OR COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES WITHIN THE FIRE DISTRICT FOR LPG OR LIQUID FUEL DEVICES THAT CAN BE TURNED ON OR OFF WHEN STAGE I-III FIRE RESTRICTIONS ARE IMPLEMENTED BY COCONINO COUNTY.


WHEREAS, the Mormon Lake Fire District will provide an open burn permit to all private or commercial properties within the Fire District Boundaries that mirror the Coconino National Forest Restrictions pertaining to LPG or Liquid Fuel Fires that can be shut on or off in areas that are barren or cleared of all overhead and surrounding flammable materials within three feet of the device. These devices shall be supervised by a responsible person at all times. All other restrictions implemented by Coconino County shall remain in effect unless a separate burn permit is issued by the Fire District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fire Board of the Mormon Lake Fire District hereby adopts, approves, and authorizes an open burn permit for all private or commercial properties within the fire district for LPG or liquid fuel devices that can be turned on or off when stage I-III fire restrictions are implemented by Coconino County.
